Construction Has Commenced



You have an opportunity to be involved from the beginning with the Ravendale Community Sports Centre

As you may be aware from recent media reports, the planning and development of the Ravendale Community Sports Centre is complete & we would like to give you the opportunity to be involved.

What has happened to date?

- ❖ Three years ago our City Council made a commitment to develop Ravendale as the premier sporting facility in Port Lincoln and locate sports facilities within easy distance of each other.
- ❖ Ravendale Community Sports Centre Inc was established over two years ago.
- ❖ A number of sports have made a commitment to locate their operations at Ravendale
 - Netball
 - Hockey
 - Baseball
 - Football
 - Little Athletics
 - Gymnastics
 - Tennis
 - Table Tennis
- ❖ The Port Lincoln Hockey Association purchased and laid a new synthetic turf pitch to International standard early in 2004.
- ❖ Council has nearly completed earthworks at Ravendale and Netball is now being played at Ravendale with their clubrooms due for completion within the next couple of months.
- ❖ The complex has been designed for competition to international standard, ovals and change rooms to suit AFL requirements, with lighting to be completed next financial year.

What is the involvement of Ravendale Community Sports Centre Inc (RCSC)?

- ❖ Initial stakeholders Tasman Football Club and PL Hockey Association formed RCSC to develop a multi purpose joint use complex for their respective sport's needs.
- ❖ The City of Port Lincoln endorsed the establishment of this joint use facility and committed to it being the only major development of it's type at Ravendale.
- ❖ Planning and design has been completed for a two-storey structure catering for 500+ patrons.
- ❖ **Funding to a total of \$2,340,000 has been arranged as follows:**
 - Tasman Football & Sporting Club – Sale of Clubrooms \$300,000
 - State Government - Sports & recreation grant \$100,000
 - City of Port Lincoln grant for public toilets and change-rooms \$400,000
 - Federal Government - Regional Partnerships grant \$500,000
 - Community Fundraising \$185,000
 - City of Port Lincoln - Dollar for dollar sponsorship up to \$155,000
 - Loan from Local Government Financing Authority \$700,000
- ❖ The Community Sports Centre will be a first class facility catering for a diverse range of uses and will be adaptable to the needs of the various sports and other recreational groups.
- ❖ The building will be adjacent to the new hockey turf and the main football oval.
- ❖ The building will be ready for the commencement of the winter sports season for 2006.

How to become involved and be recognised as a founding contributor to the RCSC

- ❖ The founding committee of the RCSC has set a community fundraising target of \$185,000 to be raised to ensure borrowings are kept at the budgeted level.
- ❖ A number of different founding sponsorship levels have been set. These include
 - Building naming rights
 - Naming rights for different sections of the building: - main hall, member's area, bar area, hockey playing field.
 - Specific founding membership donations
 - Gold foundation member \$10,000
 - Silver foundation member \$ 5,000
 - Bronze foundation member \$ 1,000
 - Buy a Brick sponsorships: -`
 - Gold \$ 500
 - Silver \$ 250
 - Bronze \$ 50

What do you get?


- ❖ Recognition will be given to all donors
